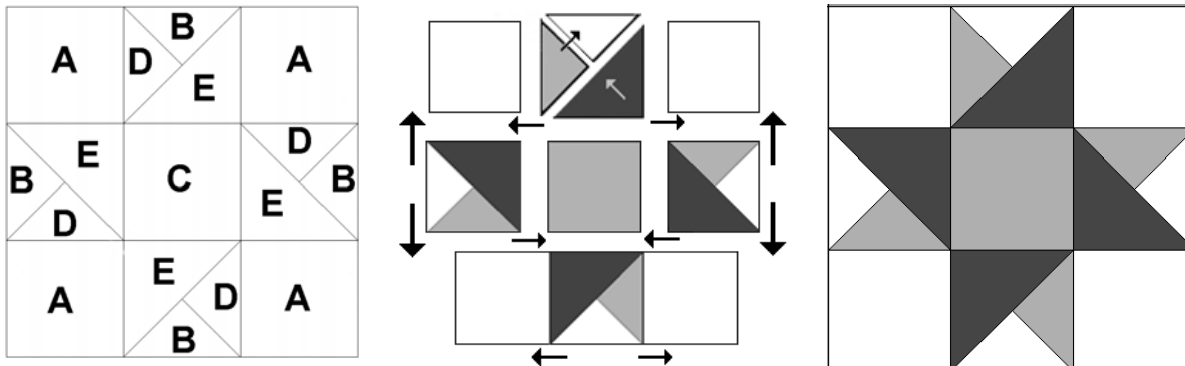
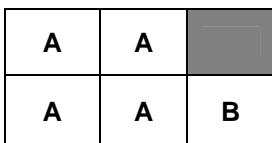


1. Florida Sunshine Star Block

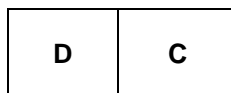

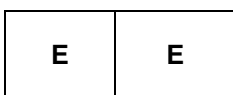
Light Fabric (A & B) 9" x 14"

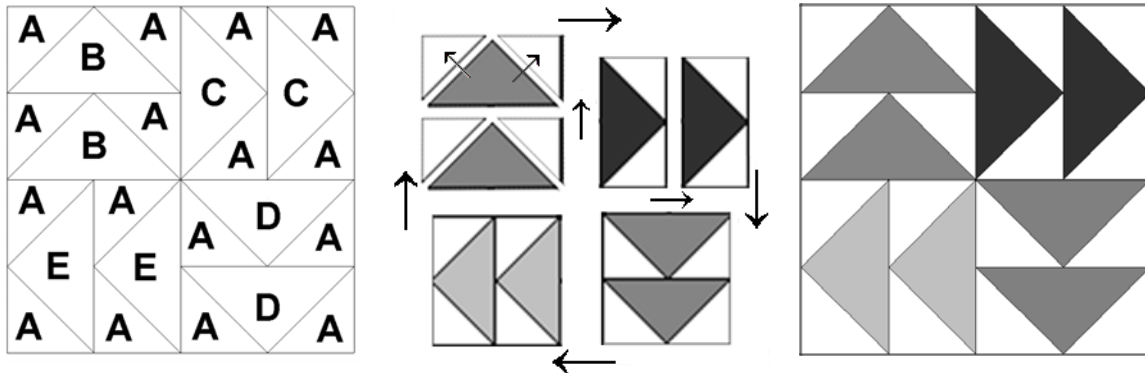

Piecing (press according to arrows in center diagram above)

1. Join B and D triangles, press seam toward B (light). Make four.
2. Join B/D to E; press toward B/D. Make four. **This unit should measure 3 7/8" square.**
3. Lay out block and assemble as a 9-patch; join horizontal rows first, then vertical rows; press rows as shown in the diagram.

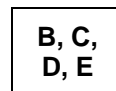

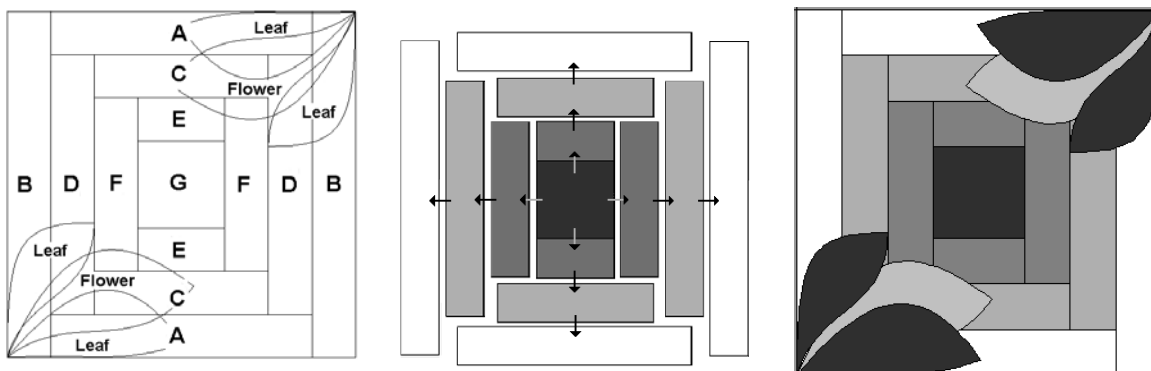

Piecing

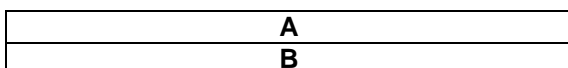
1. Join two A triangles to two Bs, Cs, Ds, and Es to make flying geese units; press toward A.
Square up if necessary to measure 3" x 5 1/2".
2. Lay out flying geese following the diagram.
3. Join pairs of flying geese to make four sections; press each toward the top unit.
This unit should measure 5 1/2" square.
4. Join horizontal rows, then vertical rows; press each section following the diagram.

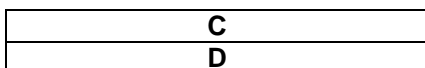

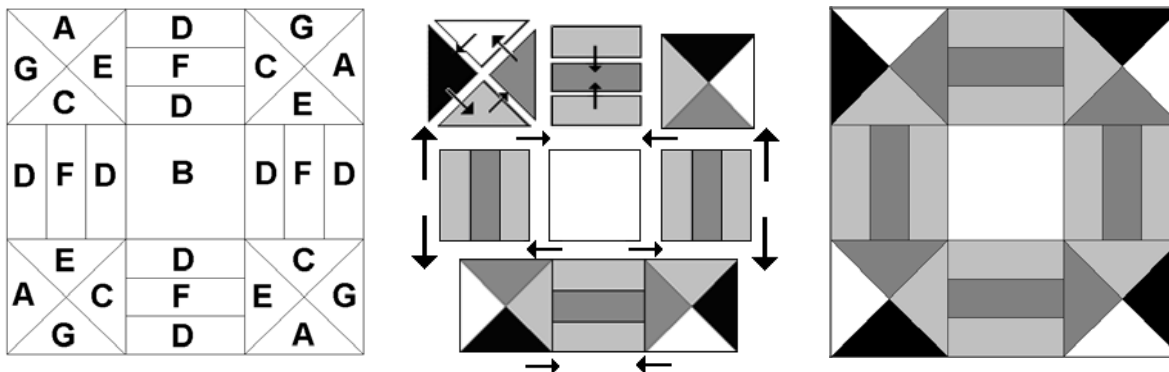
Piecing

1. Round 1: Join an E to top and bottom of G; press outward. Join F to remaining sides of G; press outward.
2. Round 2: Add a C to the top and bottom of block, then add a D to the remaining sides; press outward.
3. Round 3: Repeat Step 2 for A and B, always pressing outward.
4. Apply flower appliqués to opposite corners, flower first, then leaves. Hand or machine appliqué. If machine appliqué, seam allowance is not needed.

Hint: Stack A, C, E, and G fabrics and cut at the same time

Medium 1 Fabric (C), ~5" x 5"

Medium 2 Fabric (E), ~5" x 5"

Dark Fabric (G), ~5" x 5"

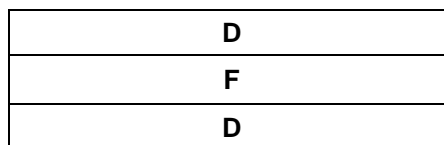
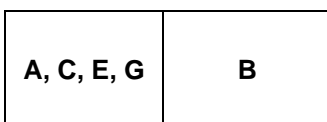
Medium 2 Fabric (F), ~2" x 22"

Medium 3 Fabric (D), two strips ~2" x 22"

Leave D and F fabrics in strips

Trim all three strips to 1 5/8" wide.
Join into a D/F/D strip set.

Stack above fabrics and cut one 4 5/8" square; from the remaining Light fabric, cut one 3 7/8" square.

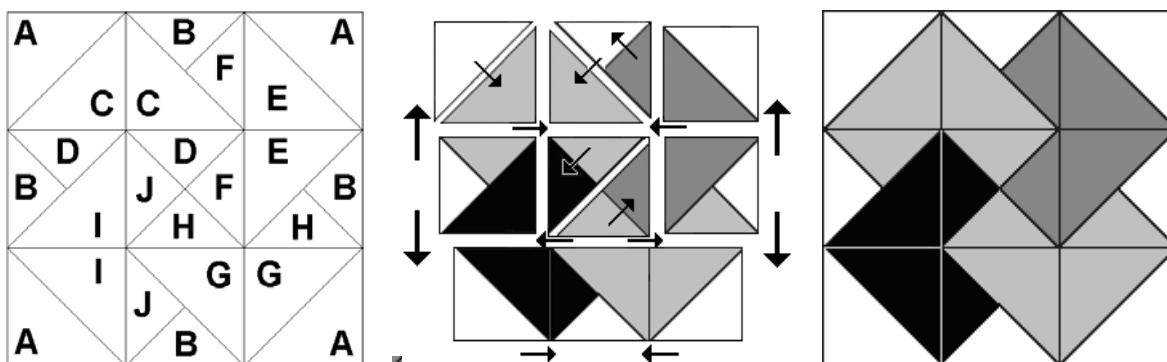
Piecing

1. Trim D and F strips to $1\frac{5}{8}$ ". Join 2 (D) strips and 1 (F) strip to form a 22" long strip $3\frac{7}{8}$ " wide; press seams inward toward F.
2. Cut the D/F/D strip unit into four $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

** Alternate method - Cut 8 of D ($1\frac{5}{8}$ X $3\frac{7}{8}$) and cut 4 of F ($1\frac{5}{8}$ X $3\frac{7}{8}$). Assemble four sets of D/F/D strips.

3. Join triangles A and G, press toward dark; join triangles E and C, press toward dark; join A/G to E/C; press remaining seam in a circle.
3. Lay out block and turn corners units so that Es create "arrow points" when placed against striped D/F/D units.
4. Assemble block as a 9 patch: join horizontal rows, then vertical rows. Press according to the diagram.

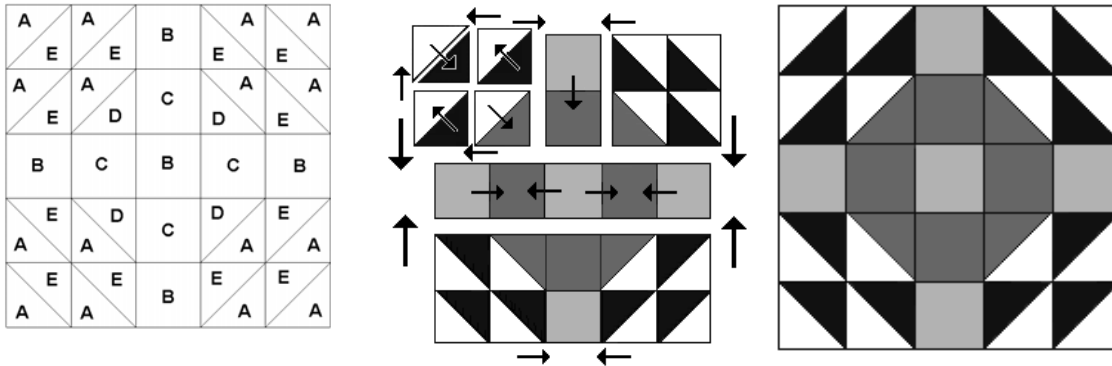

Piecing

1. Join the four A's to a C, E, G, and I; press away from A.
2. Join the four B's to a D, F, H, and J; press toward B.
3. Lay out block pieces following diagram.
4. Join the triangles from Step 2 to a C, E, G, and I; press toward the large triangles.
5. Center: Join J and D; press toward D. Join F and H; press toward H. Check to see that the triangles are in the right orientation for the pattern. Join both pieces; press remaining seams in a circle.
6. Join blocks in horizontal rows; press following diagram.
7. Join the three rows together; press following diagram.

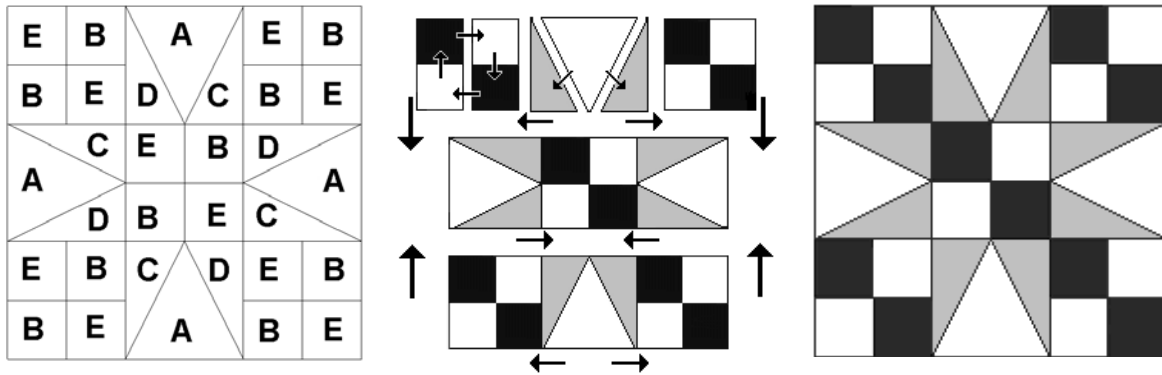

Piecing

1. Join As and Es to form half-square triangles; wait to press until step 3.
2. Join As and Ds to form half-square triangles; press toward D.
3. Lay out block following diagram. Join corner blocks to form "4 patch"; press according to diagram; press outer corner A/E toward dark; press other two A/E pieces toward light.
4. Join two B/C units. Join one B/C/B/C/B unit. Press all toward C.
5. Join the B/C units each to a corner unit; join to the other corner unit; press toward B/C.
6. Join the two units to the B/C/B/C/B unit; press toward B/C/B/C/B.

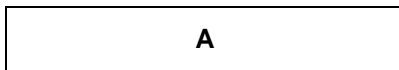

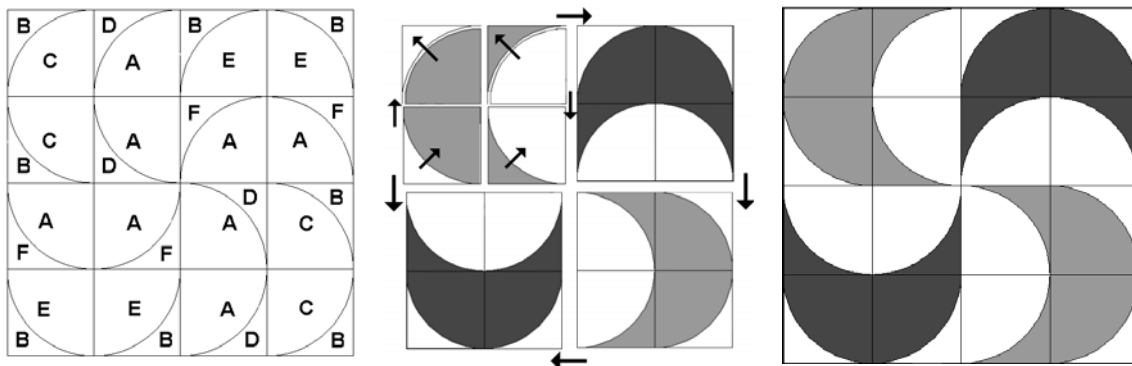
Piecing

1. Trim B and E strips to 2 1/4". Join B and E strips; press toward E.
Sewn strips should be 3 7/8" wide. Cut B/E strip into 2 1/4" sections.
2. Join two B/E units to create a 4-patch. **Make five 4-patch units 3 7/8" square** (Standard Ruler); press seams in a circle.
3. Join A and C, and D pieces to form the four middle units; press away from A.
The unit should measure ~3 7/8" square.
4. Lay out block and assemble as a 9 patch: join horizontal rows, then join vertical rows; press according to the diagram.

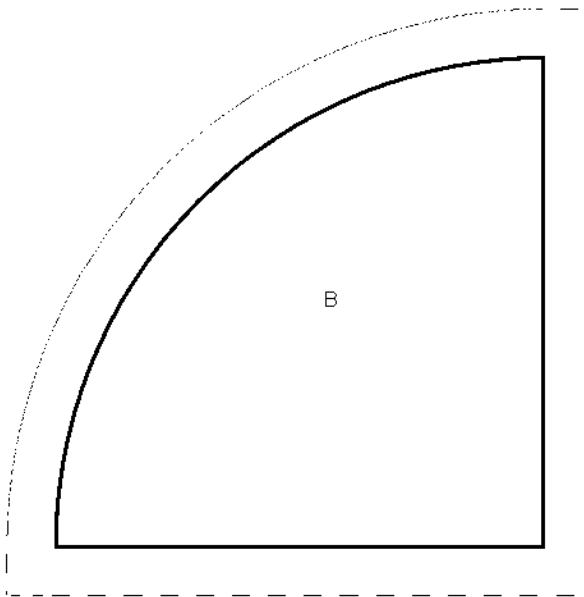
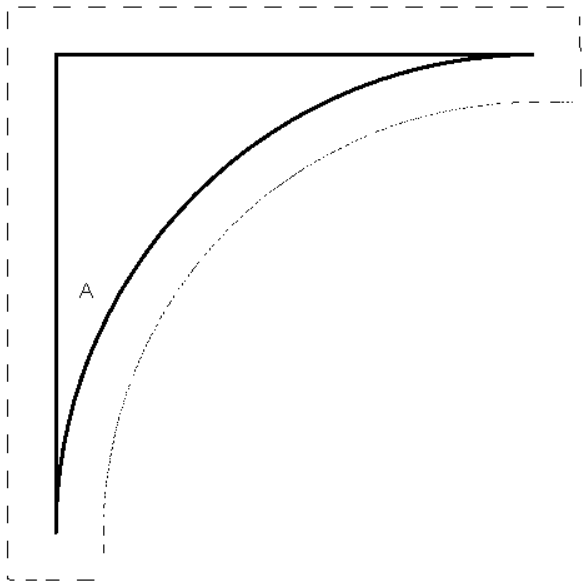

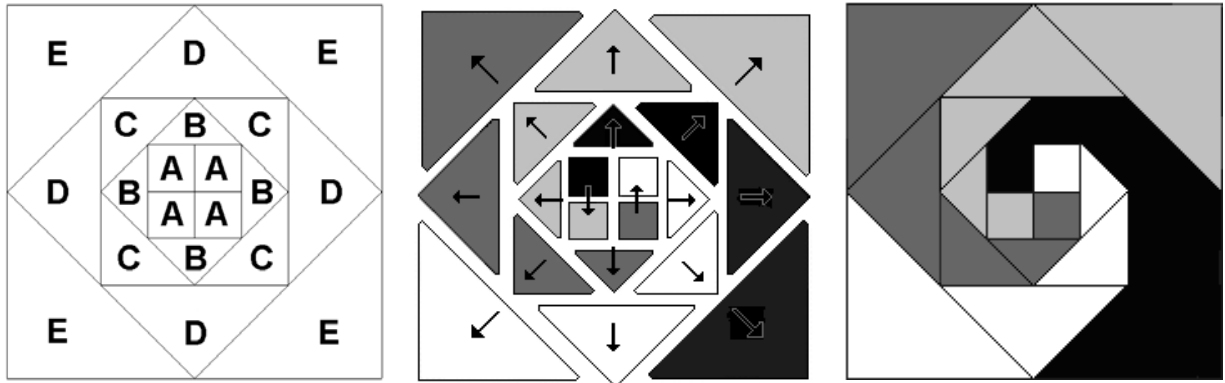

- Using template A cut 8 from Floral Fabric and using template B cut 8 from Floral Fabric. Using template A cut 4 from Medium 1 Fabric and using template B cut 4 from Medium 1 Fabric. Using template A cut 4 from Medium 2 Fabric and using template B cut 4 from Medium 2 Fabric.
- Using the diagram above, sew curved A's to curved B's to form units in the colors and design of the diagram.
- Measure your drunkard's path unit. Each unit should measure 3" unfinished. Square up if needed.
- Pieces will press in either direction. Lay out block and press according to the diagram.
- Starting in one corner, assemble into four units of four blocks each; press as indicated (in a circle).
- Join the four sections; press according to the diagram.

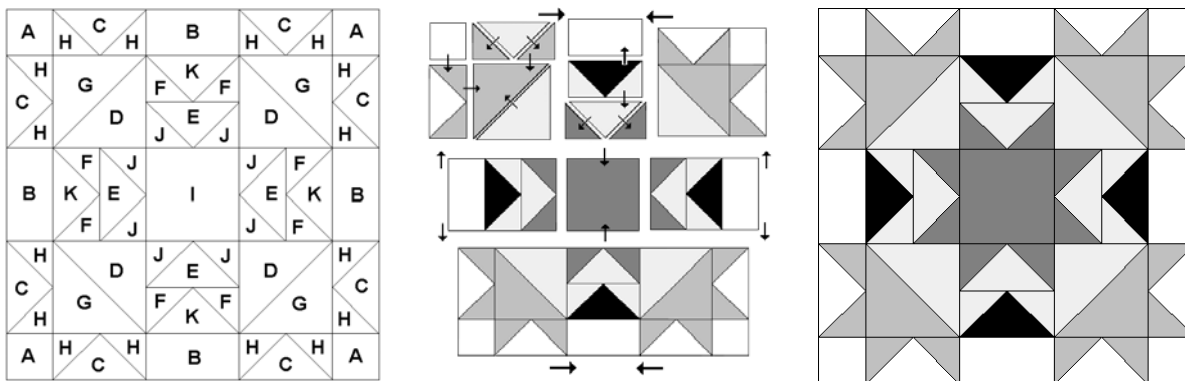
Hint: Trim points on all triangles before piecing

1. Referring to the diagram, assemble the A squares into a four patch; press each half toward dark, then press remaining seams in a circle. **Completed A unit should measure 3".**
2. Lay out the block, placing one B triangle adjacent to its matching A square. Join opposite side B triangle, and then press outward. Join last two B triangles, and then press outward.
Completed A/B unit should measure 4".
3. Referring to the diagram, repeat Step 2 for C, D, and E triangles, always pressing outward.

Completed A/B/C unit should measure 5 1/2".

Completed A/B/C/D unit should measure 7 1/2".

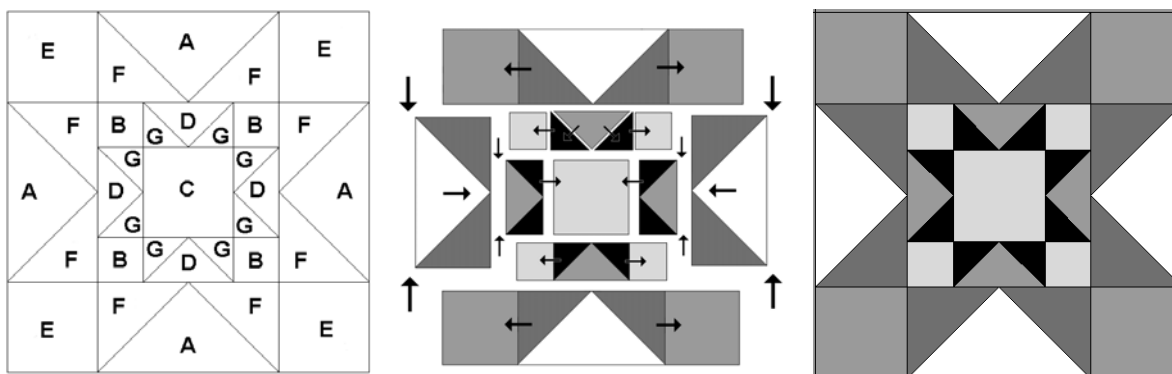

Piecing

1. Half-square triangles: Join G and D; press toward G. **The units should measure 3" square.**
2. Flying geese: Join 1 C and 2 Hs, press toward H; join 1 E and 2 Js, press toward J; join 1 K and 2 Fs, press toward F. **The units should measure 1 3/4" x 3".**
3. Corner units: Join one H/C/H to top of G/D; press toward G/D. Join A to left of H/C/H; press toward A. Join the two units together; press toward G/D. **The units should measure 4 1/4" square.**
4. Middle units: Join 1 J/EJ to a K/F/K; press toward center. Add B to the other side of J/E/J; press toward B. **The units should measure 3" x 4 1/4".**
5. Assemble as a 9 patch, following the diagram; press as indicated on the diagram.

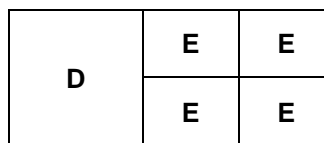
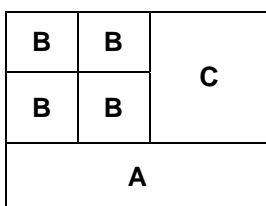

Piecing

1. Join 1 A and 2 Fs into flying geese units; press away from A. **Unit should measure 3" x 5 1/2".**
2. Join 1 D and 2 Gs into flying geese units; press away from D. **Unit should measure 1 3/4" x 3".**
3. Lay out block center and assemble as a 9 patch: join horizontal rows, then join vertical rows; press as shown in the diagram. **Center should measure 5 1/2" square.**
4. Using assembled center as one unit, also assemble remainder of the block as a 9 patch, joining horizontal rows, then vertical rows; press as shown in the diagram.

Foundation Piecing

*****Hint: Use shorter stitch length (1.5 to 2.0) for piecing foundations; change back to regular stitch length to assemble the block*****

1. On the wrong side of the foundation, place A, right side up.
2. Cover with a B strip, right side down. Turn over and pin on the paper's sewing line and check for fabric placement (check that you have allowed a 1/4" seam allowance and that when flipped out the fabrics cover the appropriate foundation areas).
3. Stitch on the paper pattern side of foundation, beginning and ending just beyond the line.
4. Fold back fabric just sewn and crease foundation on line just sewn; trim seam allowance to 1/4". Fold both back out and press.
5. Repeat Steps 2 through 4 for the C and D strips on each foundation.
6. Trim each foundation unit on the seam allowance lines.
Each foundation piece will measure 4 1/2" x 6 1/2".
(You may wish to remove the paper foundation before assembling the block).
7. Lay out block with E (Floral Fabric square) at the center. Place E over the Floral Fabric corner of a foundation unit. Starting in one dark corner, sew **half** of the seam and stop (partial seam--see top diagram); open and press.

8. Turn the pieces 90° and add another foundation unit. Match at the ends and where the stripes intersect.

To join the units using opposing seams, refold seam allowances on two of the foundation units.

Sew the foundations together; press.

9. Add the next two foundation units; open and press after each addition.
10. Complete the rest of the first partial seam; press.
