

Quilter's Unlimited
Steering Committee Meeting
August 13, 2009

The meeting was held immediately after the quilt guild meeting, with a majority of the steering committee present.

The question is whether to hire Marlene Glickman for the guild meeting and a workshop. She charges \$500 for a 4-hour workshop and meeting lecture. For the workshop, there is a choice of color collage or learn how to dye fabric. She recommends \$35 fee for the workshop, which includes materials.

Questions raised by members were: (1) can you have a lecture without the workshop, (2) how much interest is there within the guild, and (3) there's not enough time to get it organized.

There is a \$175 fee for the use of the church, the church is available for a maximum of 25 persons to attend a workshop.

It was suggested an email burst could be used to get information to members if a workshop is to be held.

Maureen Doogan made a motion to hire Marlene Glickman for the Guild meeting and for a possible workshop if enough people express interest, it was seconded by Barbara Ahlbrandt, and the ayes carried the motion. Maureen will be the contact person for this workshop. Karen Skinner volunteered to also be a contact person.

As it is unknown whether there is enough interest in the workshop, Wendy will contact Marlene Glickman as to how flexible she is for a last minute decision. Karen Skinner will do an email burst and will contact the church to schedule the workshop. She will also contact the sit 'n stitch groups re: whether there is interest in this workshop.

It is agreed there will be a \$35 fee to attend the workshop.
