


## Quilters Unlimited March 2016 Block of the Month: Rail Fence

There are several ways to create this block. One way is to create a strip set measuring 8 inches wide and 32 inches long. See picture on right. You could use 5 precut 2 ½ inch strips or a number of strips of different widths. Trim sides to 8 inch width.


Cut the strip into four 8 inch pieces and sew the pieces into a square block, rotating two of the strips to make the rail fence pattern. How you rotate the pieces will determine the look of the block.








A second way to do this is to sew a 16 inch square strip set. Cut the set into 4 pieces as shown. Rotate the pieces to produce the rail fence pattern and sew them together.
