About Entering the Show

ENTRY PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS: SLEEVE, LABEL, PILLOWCASE

The following three items must be completed before the quilt is delivered to the museum:

1. Sew a **four-inch hanging sleeve** on the back of the quilt that will allow for the thickness of the board used by the Museum to hang it (see QU website under "Lessons" for directions).
2. Sew a **label** on the back of your quilt, showing the following:

 Year Completed: _____
 Where Completed: _____
 Quilted by (if different than maker): _____
3. Bring a **pillowcase** (to hold the quilt) with your name and contact information on it.

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SUBMITTING THIS FORM

HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY ENTRY FORM WAS ACCEPTED?

When all required information has been entered into the online form, the person doing the entering will see a "Submit" button.
