

## May Block of the Month

The May block of the month is a Log Cabin block. Unfinished size (the size your block should be) is 10 1/2" square. The fabrics include white as well as your choice of colors (select just one or mix several together).



From white (W) fabric, cut the following pieces:  
One 2.5" x 2.5" (#2)  
One 2.5" x 4.5" (#3)  
One 2.5" x 8.5" (#8)  
One 2.5" x 10.5" (#9)

From scraps (S) of any color or type, cut the following pieces:  
One 2.5" x 2.5" (#1)  
One 2.5" x 4.5" (#4)  
Two 2.5" x 6.5" (#5, #6)  
One 2.5" x 8.5" (#7)



**Step 1:** Cut out your white and colored fabrics as indicated in the list shown below the layout diagram at the left.

**Step 2:** With right sides together and using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew together pieces #1 and #2. Press seam toward the darker fabric.

**Step 3:** Continue sewing the pieces together in the order indicated by the numbers in the layout diagram, always pressing seams toward the darker fabric.
