#### PHILANTHROPY

- The guild supplies batting, fabric, and instructions to those making quilts for donation to numerous worthwhile causes. Fundraising helps us buy needed supplies.
- Those receiving quilts include the following:
  - **Children** sleeping in a bed of their own for the first time — through Sleep in Heavenly Peace [approx. 250/yr.]
  - **Veterans** being honored for their service — Quilts of Valor [approx. 15/yr.] and lap quilts for disabled Veterans [approx. 30/yr.]
  - **Infants** in Neonatal ICU — to cover their mattresses or to block too much light from their isolettes [approx. 21/yr.]
  - **Patients** in Hospice — to make a hospital bed feel more like home [approx. 35/yr.]
  - **Breast Cancer Survivors** — pillows with cases to cushion seat belts [approx. 40/yr.]
