Block of the Month 2025

For January, please become a "QU Stripper".

The first block of the month for the New Year of 2025 will be an 8 and 1/2 inch square that is either sewn



diagonally or straight across, with blue and white strips. You do not need to make all of the strips the same width.



Books with the papers used for foundation will be available in January. February will be red and white, and March will be green and white. Sew as many as you want! You don't have to take off the paper on the back or clean up the edges. Just sew ("Strip") and bring to the meeting!


